

So maybe the day before, only ranks 1-50 can get their tickets between 4-5pm. Then from 5-6 it would be 51-100. Staggering like that would reduce the blockage and holdup that is caused by everyone rushing to stand in front of PNC for a couple hours before game time. Also, this would reduce the amount of people not lining up according to their rank, which may prevent the people who deserve sideline tickets from getting those tickets.

**Why do you want to be on the SWPC Board and what will you bring to it (skills/interests):** I want to be on the SWPC Board because this club has made me feel like a part of the NC State community in ways that other activities have not.
